
We nurture a positive learning culture based on a mutual respect between staff and students. This carefully developed environment supports students in their development while allowing them to become independent learners and responsible young adults.



# EASTER REVISION PROGRAMME

The Easter Revision Programme at Kings Brighton is designed for A-level or GCSE students who are preparing for their crucial examinations in May/June.

Length: 1 week per course (A-level: 4 full days per week; GCSE 4 full days or 4 half days per week)


